#### II. Classes and Themed Activities

Each Extended Day Class runs for 90 minutes. Preschoolers begin their class time with lunch (which they bring with them), circle time with the activity of the day, and playground time.

We offer an enriching and rewarding set of activities custom-tailored to our little ones. These activities vary each day; they are:

It's All About Art (Mondays): Our little ones get artistic and express their creativity by creating Art through coloring, water coloring, drawing, gluing and finger painting. This helps them develop their fine motor skills as they learn to manipulate brushes, crayons, markers and glue bottles.

Science Day (Tuesdays): Preschoolers are naturally wonderful about asking questions about the world around them. Hands-on and interactive activities engage them as they learn about the weather (enjoying time outside), practice cooking (measuring, mixing, and baking, delighting in the results), doing science experiments such as turning liquids into solids and exploring magnets.

CONTINUES ON REVERSE

**Phonics & Letters (Wednesdays):**

To build the skills that will prepare them for reading, we teach preschoolers how to identify the alphabet, recognize the sounds and letters at the beginning of words, and how to use letters to make sounds and words through poems, songs, games, flash cards and work sheets.

**Speak Spanish (Thursdays):**

Children learn a second language eight times faster than adults. Preschoolers learn how to converse in Spanish through songs, dance, stories and flash cards. Vocabulary includes words and phrases relating to school, home and the seasons.

**Music Around the World (Fridays):**

Preschoolers learn about diversity and embracing our differences by exploring various countries from around the globe and their cultures, including flags, favorite foods, folk songs and dance.

(Reminder: Lunch is not provided by St. James' Preschool)

*\*Your child's seat is guaranteed if you sign your child up by the month, however, you do have to pay whether your child attends extended day or not. For example, if your child is in the 3.5 class (A35, Monday-Thursday) and you sign him/her up for extended day Thursdays only you will pay \$320 (A35 class monthly tuition) plus \$60 (extended day monthly tuition for Thursday).*

*If you sign your child up by the day, you only pay for the day. Your child's seat is not guaranteed and you must call or email Laura Heyer first to make sure there is room for your child.*
